3 Points

Maintain 3 points of contact at all times. Have both feet and at least one hand on the ladder.

4 by 1

For every 4 foot of ladder height, the ladder should be 1 foot away. For example, if your ladder is extended 12 feet, then it should be 3 feet away from the structure.

Buddy System

Use the buddy system. Have someone to spot or hold the ladder while you are hanging lights. Cousin Eddie will be here all season!

Don't Lean

Move the ladder to where you are hanging lights. Leaning can change your base of support and cause you to fall off the ladder or cause the ladder to slip out from underneath you.
